PNH SUMMER HOLIDAY PROGRAMMES

After we had a well-deserved break during Christmas/New Year Holidays, we started the year with a blast. Both Holiday Programmes, one in-house and one for children who lived in emergency accommodation, were running smoothly even though halfway through we were moved into RED traffic light setting. Our great staff, PNH OSCAR team, did a brilliant job at adjusting the plans for the programmes. The kids had a lot of fun, and they enjoyed the meals that we provided for the programmes. We just want to say a massive thank you to all our parents and kids who have been so flexible with all the changes due to COVID traffic light level changing, your ongoing support is so much appreciated.

OMICRON IN THE COMMUNITY

Since the Omicron has been spreading in the community. We are taking a higher precaution of how we are operating each service. For our Freestore, we bag the food and give one bag each to Freestore visitor's instead of putting the food in the crates and calling numbers. This helps reduce the contact for our staff and Freestore visitors. Meetings and appointments are done via Zoom or phone calls. For Before and After School Care, our OSCAR team are trying our best to separate children from each school as much as we can and make sure they're enjoying their time at PNH. Our community support services are getting a large number of food parcel requests every day. At the rate it is going, we will be processing at least a thousand applications by the end June. Some of our services are still suspended as we classify them as high-risk activities for our staff and our community during this hard time.

THE PUKETE FREESTORE

The Pukete Freestore is a partnership with Kaivolution where food from grocery stores that would normally go to the landfill is provided free to the community. The Pukete Freestore opens at 11 am and is open to anyone and everyone. **FRUIT AND VEGETABLE BAGS AND MEAT PACKS**

These are an affordable option to feed a family of 3-4 for a week. The fruit and vegetable bags are \$12 each and come with a selection of 6-7 types of fruit and vegetables. The meat packs are \$25 for five cuts of quality meat with a halal option available.
